

2024 ANNUAL BUSINESS MEETING TOASTMASTERS INTERNATIONAL BOARD MEMBER ELECTIONS

The Board of Directors is composed of 19 elected officers and directors and the Chief Executive Officer (CEO)

Toastmasters International Board Members are elected each year at the Annual Business Meeting (ABM), a yearly assembly of the voting members of Toastmasters International.

Every member can help shape the future of the organization. Start by learning about the <u>International</u> <u>Officer and Director candidates</u> and any proposals for amendments to the <u>Bylaws of Toastmasters</u> <u>International</u> and the <u>Club Constitution for Clubs of</u> <u>Toastmasters International</u>.

The 2024 Annual Business Meeting will be held on Friday, August 16, at 7 a.m. PDT (Paris Time: Friday, Aug 16 at 4 p.m./16h), on site in California and online. Voting will be conducted electronically.

At the ABM, each Member Club in good standing is

entitled to TWO votes from the President and Secretary.

Three steps in the voting process:

- 1. Assign a proxyholder by August 9, 2024 at 11:59 p.m. PDT (Paris Time: August 10, 2024 at 2:59 p.m./14h59)
- 2. Any active Toastmasters member may be assigned as club proxyholder. To facilitate the process, however, many clubs choose to
- designate a District executive as their proxyholder. This year 2024-25 District 59 Director is Ilona Ruitenberg. Contact dd@district59.org for instructions on designating Ilona as proxy holder for your club.
- 3. Proxyholder: Complete Credentials on time.
- 4. More information about the Credentials process can be found in the Credentials FAQ (link below).
- 5.Proxyholder: Cast votes at the 2024 ABM held in Anaheim California USA & online on August 16, at 7 a.m. Pacific Daylight Time (Paris Time: August 16 at 4 p.m./16h)
